## ABC Scripture Memory List

### A = Armor

Ephesians 6:10-11

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

### B = Battle

Psalm 24:8

Who is this King of glory? The LORD, strong and mighty, the LORD, mighty in **battle**!

### C = Courageous

Joshua 1:9

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and **courageous**. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.

### D = Devote

Colossians 4:2

**Devote** yourselves to prayer; stay alert in it with thanksgiving.

### E = Endure

2 Timothy 2:3-4

**Endure** hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. No one serving as a soldier gets involved in civilian affairs—he wants to please his commanding officer.

### F = Fight

1 Timothy 6:12

**Fight** the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

**G = God**

**James 4:7**

Submit yourselves therefore to **God**. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

**H = Hope**

**Hebrews 10:23**

Let us hold fast the confession of our **hope** without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.

**I = Inheritance**

**Colossians 3:23-24**

Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the **inheritance** as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.

**J = Joyful**

**Romans 12:12**

Be **joyful** in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

**K = Kneel**

**Psalms 95:6-7**

Come, let us bow down in worship, let us **kneel** before the LORD our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.

**L = Life**

**Mark 8:35**

For whoever would save his **life** will lose it, but whoever loses his **life** for my sake and the gospel's will save it.

**M = Might**

**2 Chronicles 20:6**

O LORD, God of our fathers, are you not God in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. In your hand are power and **might**, so that none is able to withstand you.

**N = Night**

**Romans 13:12**

The **night** is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light.

**O = Overcome**

**1 John 5:4**

For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has **overcome** the world—our faith.

**P = Prepare****1 Peter 1:13**

Therefore, **prepare** your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

**Q = Quiet****Zephaniah 3:17**

The LORD your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will **quiet** you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.

**R = Refuge****Psalms 91:1-2**

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the LORD, "My **refuge** and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

**S = Spirit****Zechariah 4:6**

Not by might, nor by power, but by my **Spirit**, says the LORD of hosts.

**T = Test****1 John 4:1**

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but **test** the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world.

**U = Uphold****Psalms 119:117**

**Uphold** me that I may be safe, that I may have regard for your statutes continually.

**V = Valiantly****Psalms 60:12**

With God we shall do **valiantly**; it is he who will tread down our foes.

**W = Weapons****2 Corinthians 10:4**

For the **weapons** of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds.

**X = eXalt****Psalms 145:1**

I **exalt** you, my God the King, and bless your name forever and ever.

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my **yoke** upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

The Lord goes out like a mighty man, like a man of war he stirs up his **zeal**; he cries out, he shouts aloud, he shows himself mighty against his foes.
